

# Campgrounds Near the Lagniappe Dulcimer Society Fête

## West Baton Rouge Community Center (Fête Location)

There are camping spots next to the Community Center with water and electricity & some with electricity only. **These spots are on a first come, first serve basis for a fee of \$15.00 per night payable upon arrival. Reservations are not accepted.** Campers are advised to arrive during regular business hours. Upon arrival do not go to a site, pull into the parking lot and go to the office inside the Community Center. For information call the Community Center office at 225-336-2423. The Community Center (**NOT** the Lagniappe Dulcimer Society) handles all camping arrangements at the Community Center. There is a dump station on site for the campground.

## Farr Park Campground and Horse Activity Center

Facilities: 79 sites, 79 W & E (20 and 30 amps) 79 Pull-throughs, dump station. The park now has pass-through R.V. slots and increased 50 amp hook-ups. Directions: from I-10, Exit 158. Go 5 1/2 miles south on College (which becomes Lee Drive; then becomes Brightside Lane) then one half-mile south on River Road enter on left. Rate: \$20.00 per night. This campground does not make reservations. Credit cards are accepted (except American Express) Phone: 225-769-7805



The Baton Rouge KOA is located approximately 20 miles from Port Allen. Take I-10 West from Port Allen to I-12 toward Hammond, LA. Take the Denham Springs Exit 10 from I-12. Head south on Range Road; turn west (right). Camp ground is on the left. Please call ahead for reservations.
